**Scholarships:**

- ❖ \$25 scholarship awarded randomly to 4 bowlers who do not cash in tournament. (name in pool once, regardless of re-entries).
- ❖ \$25 scholarship awarded to the 4 highest handicapped series bowlers that did not cash in tournament.
- ❖ \$25 scholarship awarded to the bowler with the highest handicapped game bowled that did not cash in tournament.
- ❖ 100% payout, additional scholarships will be awarded to zero out the prize fund. Tournament Director will determine how these will be awarded.
- ❖ Brackets available each shift. **Brackets will be 100% paid in form of additional scholarship.** Brackets are \$5 each 1st Place: \$25, 2<sup>nd</sup> Place: \$15

# RULES

2. **All entrants must be current USBC members.**
3. **Dress code will be enforced, 20 point penalty per game if not followed:** slacks and collared shirt or USBC youth shirt. "Nice" jeans acceptable (no holes, frays, bad hems). No underwear showing, hats/caps, shorts, skirts, sunglasses, tanks or sleeveless shirts.
4. Handicap will be 90% of 220.
5. **Tournament is divided into 8 divisions which are based on age as of August 1, 2009.**

i. Boys	Age 8 & under	Age 9-11	Age 12-14	Age 15-18
ii. Girls	Age 8 & under	Age 9-11	Age 12-14	Age 15-18
6. **Entering average:** must consist of at least 21 games. Use your highest 2008/2009 – (we will verify these with the USBC website). If no 2008/2009 average, you will use your highest current book average (make sure to bring your current league average standing sheet or you will bowl scratch). Any bowler without a current 21 game average or 2008/2009 average will bowl scratch.
7. **A bowler may enter more than once, but may only earn one scholarship for highest position.**
8. ALL winnings (scholarships) will be deposited in the SMART Account #2048.
9. **ENTRY FEE:** \$15 per bowler per entry (\$7.00 lineage, \$7.00 awards, \$1.00 expenses). This must be paid with the entry form or you will be considered a walk-in.
10. Brackets will be available at \$5 per bracket. Paying 1<sup>st</sup> as \$25.00 and 2<sup>nd</sup> as \$15.
11. **Behavior & etiquette:** Bowlers are expected to behave in mature manner. Single lane courtesy, no coaching into settee area, no flash devices, no electronics in settee areas, no foul or abusive language, no running, jumping, dancing or sliding around. Only bowlers and tournament workers allowed in settee area. Violations may cause disqualification.
12. **WALK IN's will be accepted 30 minutes before shift (or sooner) but no later... IF there are openings.**
13. **WALK-IN's must pay a \$5 Late Processing fee added to FIRST entry only.**
14. Refunds only at the discretion of the tournament director
15. **Bowlers should check in at least 30 minutes prior to scheduled shift time.** Bowlers not present at the scheduled time will be permitted to bowl starting with the current frame being bowled. Zero for all frames missed. Failure to appear for scheduled time forfeits the reservation and the entry fee. The tournament manager reserves the right to declare an emergency due to weather or conditions beyond our control.
16. Not responsible for INJURY or LOSS of personal items
17. Number of entries will determine the number of additional scholarship payouts. Scholarship payout ratio will be at least 1:10 per division. Tournament will have 100% payout of Awards Fund in the form of SMART scholarships.
18. Checks returned for non-sufficient funds or closed account will **void all** winnings for bowler (including brackets). Bowlers score will be changed to zero for all games.
